The Old Yard Coffee Shop

Hovingham Stores

Hovingham Stores sells virtually everything. Open 06:00 to 20:00 Mon to Sat, 07:30 to 20:00 Sun

Newspapers can be ordered from Hovingham Stores. They are collected every day except Sunday and put in the green box at The Square on Church Street.

Milk and veg

Post office

The mobile post office is in Low Street (west end) for an hour, Tue from 15:15 and Thu from 08:30.
